EXAMPLE : NW Bicester Eco-Town

NW Bicester was the site for Teambuild 2012. It provided an exciting project to plan and build an eco settlement to the highest standards of sustainability. Not only in construction techniques but also in the choices we make about energy, transport and biodiversity to create a place to live, work and play.

Teams worked on hypothetical scenarios, informed by the real site constraints of NW Bicester. It was a great opportunity to explore sustainable design and construction, a key part of the future career of every young professional.

Teambuild promotes core

understanding and co-operation between young professionals in the construction industry and counts as 4 days CPD as well as helping competitors fulfil several of the core objectives required for chartered membership of many institutions.

Now in its twenty-third year, the competition continues to attract the

brightest young professionals from some of the best construction practices around the UK and Ireland.

Teams produce a short prequalification document in September, from which only nine teams qualify to join the finals weekend at an excellent UK conference venue. Unsuccessful teams are not empty-handed- they receive specific feedback from judges and a certificate for one days' CPD.

The nine finalist teams are made up of six individuals from varying disciplines, including architecture, structural engineering, environmental engineering, contractors, project management, interior and urban design, and surveying.

The teams have to role-play and respond to challenging questions that would rattle the most experienced of presenters.
